Step-By-Step Directions

- 1.) Score the Old Olive card stock at 3 7/8", 4 5/8", 8 1/2", and 9 1/4". Crease score lines using a Bone Folder.
- 2.) Adhere all of the Designer Series Papers to their corresponding layers of Early Espresso card stock. Adhere the back panel to the back of the project. Adhere the side panels to the sides of the project.
- 3.) Adhere 3 mini magnets to the back of the Early Espresso piece that will become your front flap using Sticky Strip. Put one Glue Dot on top of each magnet. Put Sticky Strip around each edge of that piece and adhere to the front flap of your project.

- 4.) Allow 3 mini-magnets to attach to the inside of the front flap. Apply one Glue Dot to each of the mini-magnets and close the flap. This will cause the magnets to adhere to the front of your project. Cover them with a piece of Sticky Strip. Apply Sticky Strip to the front layer of Early Espresso/Designer Series Paper and attach to the front of your project, covering the magnets. The magnets in the flap should “click” with the magnets under the front to close the cover.
- 5.) Take the piece of 3 5/8” x 5 3/4” Early Espresso card stock and run it through the Big Shot in the Honeycomb Textured Impressions Folder. Adhere it to the inside cover using Snail Adhesive.
- 6.) Using both pieces of 4 1/2” x 5 1/4” Designer Series Paper, create Scallop Envelopes using the Big Shot and the Scallop Envelope Die. Fold on the score lines with a Bone Folder. Glue as shown in video. Attach to the Early Espresso/inside flap of the front cover to create 2 pockets.
- 7.) Score the 5 3/4” x 7 3/4” piece of Early Espresso card stock at 3 5/8” and 4 1/8”. Fold on score lines with a Bone Folder. Run this piece through the Big Shot using the Honeycomb Textured Impressions Folder on the front panel. This is the inside piece that will cover your Note Pad. Fold the Ribbon and attach to this piece as shown in Video to hold the pen. Secure with Sticky Strip. Apply Sticky Strip to the back panel and attach to the project.
- 8.) Use a piece of 4 1/2” x 5 1/4” Early Espresso card stock and the Big Shot and Scallop Envelope Die to create another mini envelope and attach it to the inside flap of the Early Espresso inside panel to create a pocket.
- 9.) Using the large Framelit from the Apothecary Arts Collection, cut out a piece of Designer Series Paper and adhere it to the front of the Honeycomb piece to cover the ribbon.

Stamp a greeting from the Feel Goods Stamp Set onto Very Vanilla card stock using Early Espresso Ink and Emboss with Clear Embossing Powder and a Heat Tool. Using the 3rd Smallest Framelit from the Labels Collection and the Big Shot, cut out the greeting and apply Stampin’ Dimensionals to the back. Adhere on top of the Apothecary Art/Designer Series Paper cut out.

Use the 3/8” Circle Punch from the Itty Bitty Punch Pack to punch out a piece of DSP and layer onto a Builder Brad. Cover with one of the Bubbles that come with the Brads. Flatten the Brad legs and adhere to the front flat of your project using Glue Dots.

Put Sticky Strip on the cardboard backing of a 3” x 5” White Note Pad and adhere to the back flap of the INSIDE Early Espresso cover as shown in the video.
